Applications are invited from GAT-B 2026 qualified students for admission to **M Tech. Marine Biotechnology** programme sponsored by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India and offered by Cochin University of Science and Technology at National Centre for Aquatic Animal Health, for the Academic Year 2026-2027.

Eligibility: Candidates with minimum 60% marks or equivalent CGPA (under grading system) from any recognized university in B.Tech. or BE in Biotechnology/M.Sc. in any branch of Life Science with qualifying GAT-B 2026 Score (Un-Reserved (UR) - 128, Economically Weaker Sections (Gen-EWS): 91, OBC-NCL: 93.5, Scheduled Caste (SC): 65, Scheduled Tribe (ST): 60, Differently Abled (DA: 60) under each category can apply for admission to the M.Tech. Marine Biotechnology programme.

The reservation norms as per the guidelines of Government of India for DBT supported PG teaching courses will be adopted for admission.

The total intake for the programme is 20

(Seat allocation: Unreserved (General):10; Gen-EWS:2, OBC-NCL:4,; SC:3, ST: 1, Differently Abled: 5% horizontal reservation).

The application is open from 17-06-2026 to 27-06-2026. The rank list will be published on 30th June 2026.

The selected candidates need to remit an application fee of Rs. 1500/- for General/OBC/EWS/DA categories and Rs. 700/- for SC/ST candidates **at the time of admission**. The selected candidates are eligible for a studentship of Rs.12000 per month.
